Dear Co-workers in the Kingdom:

PLEASE READ THIS LETTER UNTIL THE END.

One of our earliest converts, (baptized over 18 years ago), brother Williams is standing in his destroyed home. The church building where he serves was totally destroyed in the earthquake 11 years ago. It was rebuilt from the ground up. Brother Williams has served in his community and converted many a denominational congregation. The second quake this last August destroyed his home. We all helped him to rebuild. You see his own personal home, totally restored. This was done with the funds which you all provided. We feel so blessed for the funds that were so generously given. We received about \$24,000 to feed the needy and we even were able to restore some church buildings and a preacher's home. Sure, there are still about 25 church buildings that need to be repaired but we trust that God will provide even in these Corona times.

This is what leads me to a very serious matter. We need urgent financial help on a monthly basis. Due to Corona, several of our supporting churches had to cut or totally eliminate our support. This has devastating implications. There are almost no funds left for Haiti. This is serious for all of us involved in this great work. We must not throw in the towel at this crucial time. Sure, we have many churches that are already self-supporting but many, many are not. They need us, especially the education of preachers is still very necessary. Many of our new congregations will not survive being abandoned. We need help.

URGENTLY! Maybe there is help available. Please, don't let our labor be in vain.

This great work must not be abandoned. It must continue to bring fruit and with your help this will be accomplished.

I wish you all a blessed holiday and a Good New Year.

Please, pray for us. This is the greatest crisis we have experienced. We need help.
