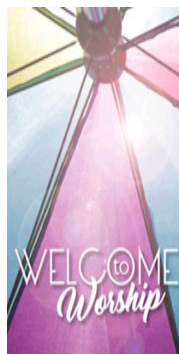

Kevin's Korner

Is Your Anger Under Control?

I read recently that "your temper is one of your most valuable possessions, so don't lose it!" There is a lot of truth in that statement. We discussed last week that anger is not always sinful. If it was, then God sinned in Exodus 4:14 when He became angry. It would also mean that Jesus sinned in Mark 3:5 when He became angry. But, we know that neither the Father nor His Son ever sinned or ever will sin. There are simply times and places when anger for the right reasons is justified. However, it is when we become angry for the wrong reasons, lose control of our anger (letting it control us), or dwell on our anger for long periods of time that we provide a way for sin to enter our lives.

Paul's letter to the church at Ephesus instructed them to "*Be angry, and yet do not sin.*" We continue this week in Ephesians 4:26 & 27 with "the rest of the story." Paul writes, "*do not let the sun go down on your anger, and do not give the devil an opportunity.*" Paul was trying to convey to these first century Christians the dangers of anger. Those dangers are the same dangers that we face today. It is not anger, itself, that is always the problem. Further problems arise when we allow our anger to take root and grow in our lives, rather than quickly resolving it. When we fail to put a swift end to our anger, we "*give the devil an opportunity*" to tempt us with all kinds of sinful conduct.

Paul also taught in Ephesians 4:31 that we must "*let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.*" Why? The answer is simple. These spiritual hazards will draw one away from God and the eternal peace He offers.

In practically the same breath, however, Paul teaches us what we need in order to draw closer to God through Christ Jesus. He writes in Ephesians 4:32, "*Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.*" In other words, we need to act and react just like Jesus did!

God does not forbid us from ever being angry. There are some things that merit certain frustrations. However, God does want us to control our emotions. In fact, He wants us to control all aspects of our lives as we strive to serve Him and grow closer to Him. Remember, "anger" is just one letter short of "danger!"

How to Maintain a Clear Mind (Romans 12:1-2)

The human mind is an amazing creation of God; nothing on earth can match its capacity or creativity. It controls feelings, thoughts, words, attitudes, and behavior. Who we become and what we achieve depends largely on how and what we think.

Ask: Is it not logical to let the One who created us guide our way of thinking?

A clear mind is one that is aligned with God's Word and controlled by His Spirit. When the Lord has authority over our thoughts, discernment guards our perspective. He enables us to look beyond the surface and see situations as they really are. We can distinguish not only between right and wrong but also between the good and the best. The Lord has given us the ability to think rightly, no matter what problems we may face.

However, we must choose and steadfastly maintain that clear, focused way of thinking. If we do not guard ourselves against the world's influence, we will soon find ourselves with a fragmented mind—unable to focus on spiritual matters because it has become confused and cluttered with worldly thoughts and concerns. We must carefully consider what we allow into our minds.

Ask yourself: "Does this help me become the person God wants me to be, or does it hinder that process?" A renewed mind begins with surrendering to the Lord. When we grant God full authority over our thoughts, we gain the power to clear away the confusion that prevents us from living in the fullness of His will. As we fill our minds with His Word, He will transform our lives.

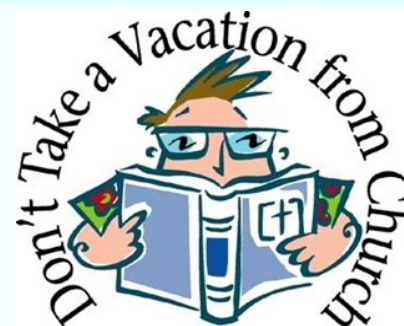
