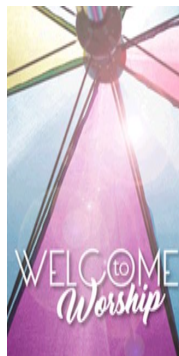

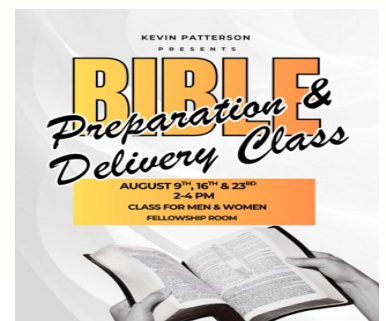

"My Church" and the One Body

Jesus said, "I will build My church" (Matthew 16:18). That promise answers the question, "Whose church really matters?" The church that matters is the one that belongs to Christ, not to men. Peter had just confessed, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God," and Jesus said that revealed truth is the rock on which His church would stand. The church is built on Christ's identity and authority, not on culture, family tradition, or human religion.

Later, Paul could say, "There is one body and one Spirit... one Lord, one faith, one baptism" (Ephesians 4:4-5). Many congregations meet in many places, but God sees one spiritual body joined to one Lord by one gospel. That one body is the "My church" Jesus promised to build. When people treat church as a matter of taste—"pick the one you like"—they ignore that Christ claimed ownership of a single people bound together by His truth.

Only one church truly matters: the church that confesses Jesus as the Son of God and submits to His word, becoming part of the one body He created. The real question is not, "Which church fits me?" but "Am I in the church that belongs to Him?"

Kevin's Korner

A Lie is a Lie is a Lie!

A certain woman, preparing to entertain guests, went to a small grocery store to buy food. She stopped at the meat counter and asked the attendant for a large chicken. He reached down into the cold storage compartment, grabbed the last chicken he had, and placed it on the scale. "This one weighs four pounds, Ma'am," he said.

"I'm not sure that four pounds will be enough," the woman replied. "Do you have a bigger one?"

The annoyed attendant put the chicken back into the compartment, pretended to search through the melting ice for another one, and then brought out the very same bird. Discreetly applying some finger pressure to the scale, he said to the woman with a smile, "Ah, this one weighs six pounds."

"I'm still not sure that will be enough," the woman said with a frown. "I'll tell you what. Wrap both of them up for me, and I'll buy the two!"

You may have heard the old saying, "Honesty is the best policy." Well, we live in an age when fewer and fewer people are adopting that policy. Some types of lying are even acceptable in the eyes of some people. But, lying has NEVER been acceptable in the eyes of God. We can call a lie by any other name (a little white lie, a well-intentioned lie, a half-truth to spare another's feeling, a lie of omission, etc.), but a lie is still a lie, and lying has ALWAYS been wrong.

Under the Old Testament in Exodus 20:16, God gave the following commandment to the Jews: "*You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.*" In other words, do not lie!

Now, we live under a different law that is found in the New Testament. Paul once told some Christians in Colossians 3:9 & 10, "*Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices, and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him.*" In other words, do not lie!

Ulbert's Perspective

When We Cry Out to God (Psalm 57:1-3)

When you face a crisis, what is the first thing you do? The natural response is to try to solve the problem using your own strength. However, God offers us a different way to face difficulties.

David was no stranger to pressure or the sudden onset of trouble. When he wrote **Psalm 57**, he was facing many hardships, including persecution by King Saul, who sought to kill him (**1 Sam. 24**). The shepherd's response was to cry out to God and take refuge in Him until the calamity passed.

Let us learn from David's example by examining his words. Today, we will focus on the One to whom the psalmist cries out.

First, David refers to God as ***El Elyon***, or Supreme Ruler; He is the Highest—possessing all power and wisdom, the only One who can help us in our time of need.

Second, the psalm states that God is our refuge. If He is a place of refuge for our soul, then we need not fear. He hovers over us and protects us when crises arise.

Third, the psalm expresses complete confidence that the Almighty can—and will—accomplish all things. He will do whatever is necessary to intervene on our behalf and to hold accountable those who attack us, surrounding us with His love and His truth.

During His time on Earth, Jesus demonstrated His great love. Therefore, we can draw near Him when our hearts are troubled. Know that you can come before the throne of the One who is your mighty protector—One who has both the power and the desire to bring about everything you need. So, let us learn to call out to Him.

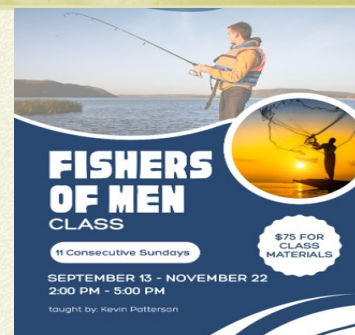
